MAASAI

*Considered as the World's Most Primitive Culture
Now Entering an Extraordinary Destiny*

Approximately 1 million Maasai reside in the remote bush country of Eastern Africa, and have, until now, been adamantly closed to outsiders. Recent missionary work blessed by the hand of God has opened this primitive culture to an extraordinary destiny.

TWO-FOLD PURPOSE

1. "Wells of Restoration" will provide fresh water for the first time to 10 communities in the sparsely populated semi-arid area known as Maasai Land. Lawn mower engines, high tech wind turbines, local labor and simplicity combine to produce low cost water wells and lighting. All 10 wells, drilling & transportation equipment cost less than the cost of 2 traditional wells. A vocational school will continue the drilling project on into the future.

A micro-garden in Maasai Land has already grown the Chinese herbal tea that has both prevented and cured Malaria. The water wells will also provide irrigation to four demonstration farms that will grow the herbal crop to be given to the poor. This will serve as demonstrations to be expanded into 30 Sub-Saharan countries with prospects of curing Malaria throughout Africa.

2. "Call of GLORY" is an evangelistic outreach to the Maasai. Leaders gathering in Nairobi, Kenya in April 2010 made known their secret as being the 13th Tribe of Israel, the descendants of Menassah, Son of Joseph of Egypt. The Maasai came to repentance and proclaim Jesus Christ as the Messiah. Their rich traditions and obedience to elders will rapidly lead the entire Tribe into Christianity.

Christian Maasai ministers are currently establishing an inclusive evangelism outreach effort, so that not one be left behind. The enclosed ministry and evangelism programs will provide a fast startup for noble endeavor. By 2012 all Maasai are expected to be Christian, and their well known moral integrity will have a profound effect upon Africa and Believers around the world.

INTRODUCTION TO PARTICIPANTS

Maasai are considered to be the most primitive culture in the world and the most fierce warriors. For 2,600 years they have lived in seclusion, scattered throughout the bush country of Eastern Africa, and were considered “unreachable” by mainline dominations. Recently they have become alive to their destiny as the 13th Tribe of House of Israel.

Ministry International Inc. (MII) is a small, international ministry to equip, train ministers, and provide resources in a global field. Through donations MII is able to establish schools in third world countries and train quality students here in the states with our Fullness of God vision. MII has provided accredited ministry training for 32 Maasai men and women, and in 2010 has organized a financial support program for 20 active ministers. Reference <http://Ministryinternational.tv>

African Restoration is an endeavor established by Leonard Heatherly to bring social, spiritual and economic well being to the peoples of Africa. The restoration is to begin with the Maasai and the defeat of Malaria. Demonstration farms are being established to grow an herbal preventative and cure, which will be distributed free to the poor through a ministry alliance. Reference <http://African-Restoration.info>

RECO NGO, an international, non-governmental organization, registered in Kenya as Restoration of Eastern Commonwealth Organization for drilling water wells. 5,000 such wells would be needed to meet the total need of the Maasai. However, 7.5 million KES will buy initial equipment and complete the first 10 wells, and bring healing to 100,000 poor people in Maasai Land. Reference <http://restorationofeasterncommonwealth.org>

Maasai Mission, an association of Christian ministries among the Maasai, that has a two-fold purpose: (1) establish 10 water wells and 4 demonstration farms in Maasai Land to provide clean drinking water, irrigation of the herbal crop and meeting place for ministry; (2) establish an evangelism outreach for Maasai ministers to reach all of their people. WELLS OF RESTORATION

Restoration of Eastern Commonwealth (RECO) is a newly organized, independent non-profit international NGO in Kenya, initially request a grant of \$100,000 USD.

10 Water Wells

These wells will provide fresh drinking water to Maasai in the remote bush country, and will provide irrigation for demonstration farms to grow the herbal remedy for Malaria. While 7.5 million KES may produce only 1 or 2 traditional wells, this project will establish 10 low cost, shallow water wells to accommodate remote villages. Thus, provide the first clean water to 2,000 Maasai initially. Beside the humanitarian benefit of providing fresh drinking water to a people who have lived in virtual isolation for 2,600 years, these wells are essential to growing a proven herbal remedy that is both a preventative and cure for Malaria.

A vocational training program to continue drilling wells in a self-sustaining program for dozens more wells each year. The small demonstration farms growing the herbal remedy for Malaria, are the first steps in bringing the “Defeat of Malaria” to all of Africa.

NOTES

1. The drill is manufactured in the USA and has been used successfully in more than 100 countries. The vehicle must be a covered van appropriate for rugged terrain. An assortment of minor equipment is required in support of the drilling operation.
2. Educational opportunity is virtual priceless in that it will empower Maasai and other groups to have the know how to establish low cost wells in an ongoing program.
3. Existing shallow wells in the area prove its feasibility. The creative application of high technology and low cost techniques make 10 wells possible for the usual cost of 1.

Cure & Prevention of Malaria

According to the World Health Organization, 300 million suffer from Malaria throughout Sub-Saharan Africa. The children are the hardest hit, claiming the lives of 3,000 children each day.

A cup of tea, and none would die!

Accomplishing what billions of dollars could not, a simple herbal tea cures Malaria. Wormwood tea has been used successfully for thousands of years in China. An oil from the herbal plant is currently used in expensive patent medicine Coartem.

EVANGELISM OF MAASAI

Spiritual Calling

The ancient Tribe of Maasai, under the leadership of Bishop Josiah Muesha, are responding to the "Call to GLORY" - a call to repentance, declaring Jesus Christ Lord and for restoration, now taking their place in the Kingdom on earth. Having lived for many generations simple moral lives as cattlemen in the deep bush country of Eastern African, Maasai have an advantage in not being materialistic like modern men.

Maasai are deeply spiritual and were willing to walk for many days to search for the source of God's calling. This was demonstrated so dramatically in Nairobi in April 2010 as Maasai from Burundi, Congo, Ethiopia, Somalia, Tanzania, Uganda and various regions of Kenya gathered at Nairobi.

During the gathering the representatives of the Tribe of Maasai celebrated their being redeemed from the curse through Jesus Christ and their calling to take their place in destiny. Signs and wonders followed the inspired preaching and many testified of their dramatic healing. The pinnacle of the gathering was their embrace of Jesus as Lord and their heritage as an intact Tribe of Israel. This was highlighted by their deep intercessory prayer for Maasai, Israel and all of Africa.

Evangelism of Maasai

Currently they are organizing an inclusive evangelism effort such that no Maasai will be left behind. By 2012 they hope to reach virtually all 1 million Maasai who are scattered through Eastern Africa. Old fashion crusades will not be effective; this unique culture requires an unique approach.

Reaching effectively into the sparsely populated, semi-aiired lands requires a combination of the old circuit rider with adaptation of high technology. This involves traveling over rugged terrain with an excellent communication devices.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

MII has already scholarshipped 32 Maasai men and women to accredited ministry training. Additionally 50 more are expected to begin training in July, who will be ready to enter the ministry field in the coming year.

One of the large concerns for ministers with families is the education of their children. Schools are not free. Tuition of \$300 per semester per child is common, which is an amount far in excess of most families total income. Therefore, a sponsorship program is organized; whereby donations can be made to provide for the education of a minister's child.

The 6 month (semester) budget for the education programs follows:
